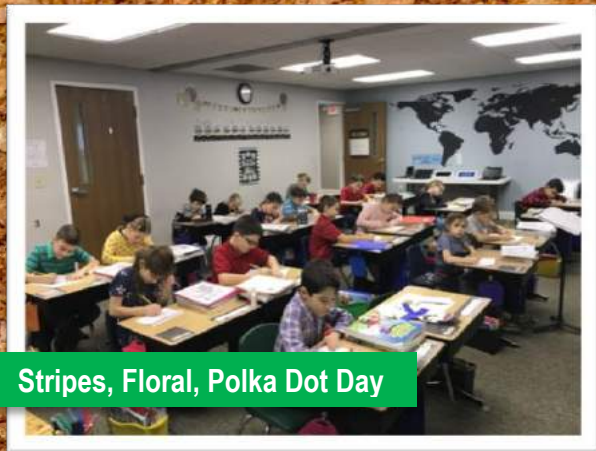

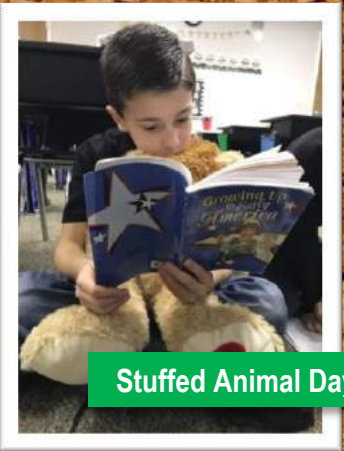
The First Place Dog

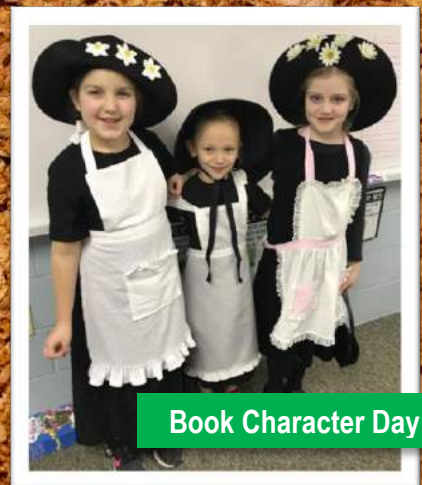

February Fun Days, which included Book Character Day and Twin Day, and dressing up in 1920s or 2120 fashion for the 100th day of school were so fun!



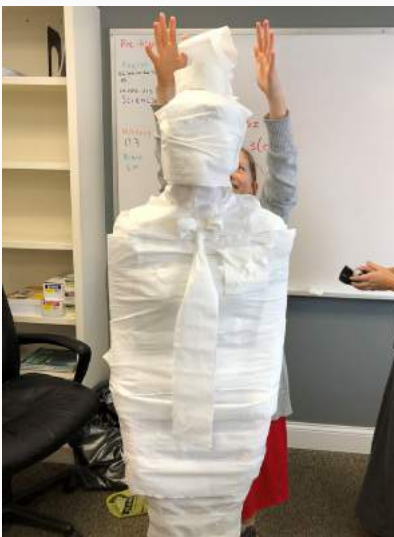

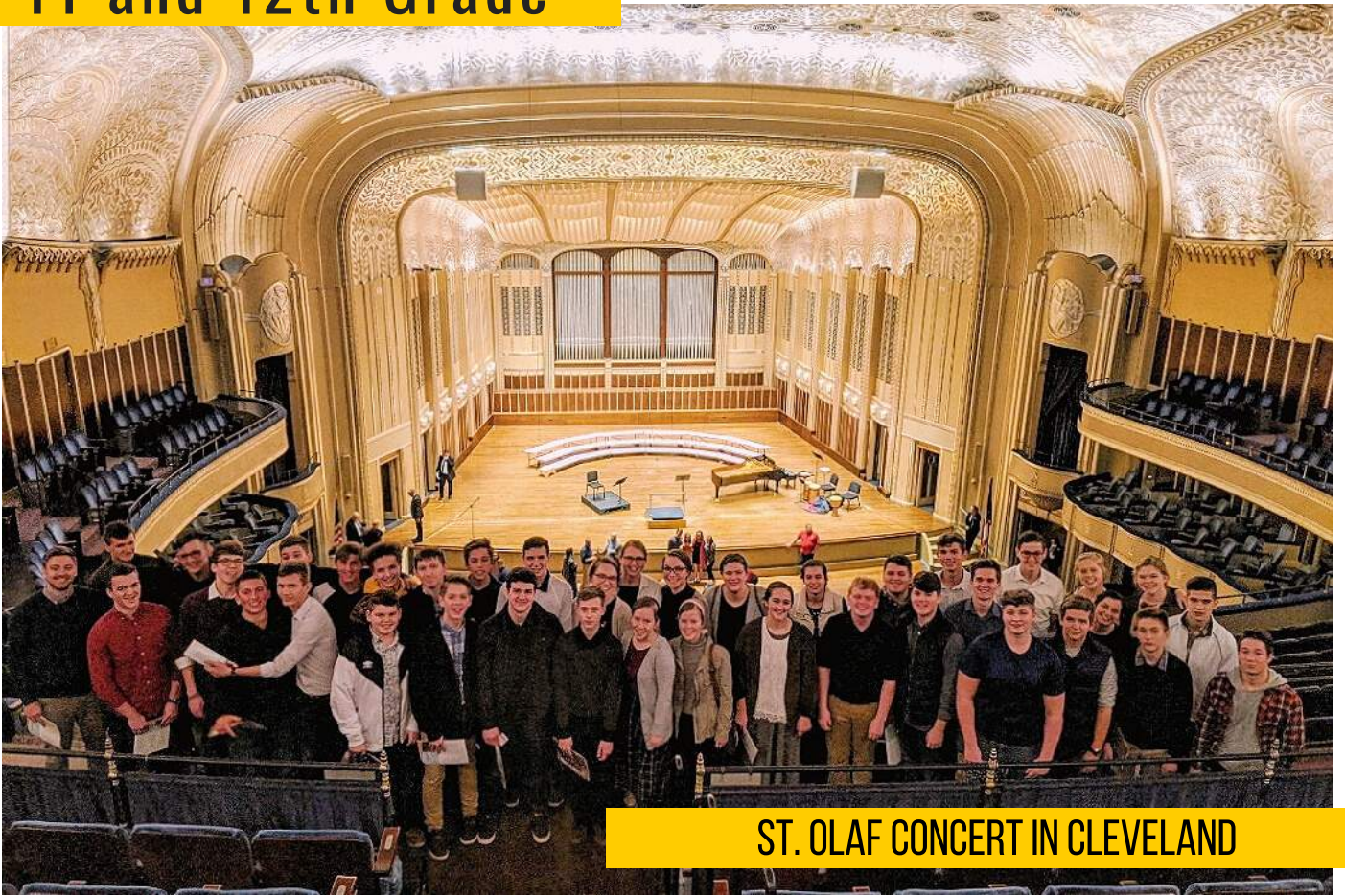
GEOGRAPHY CLASS

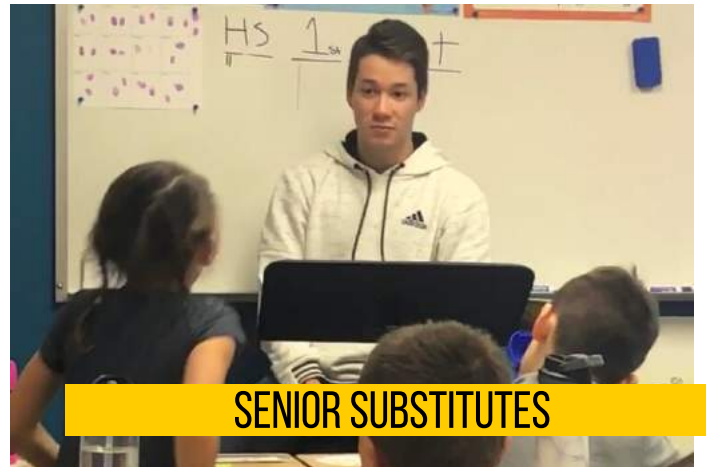
SCIENCE CLASS

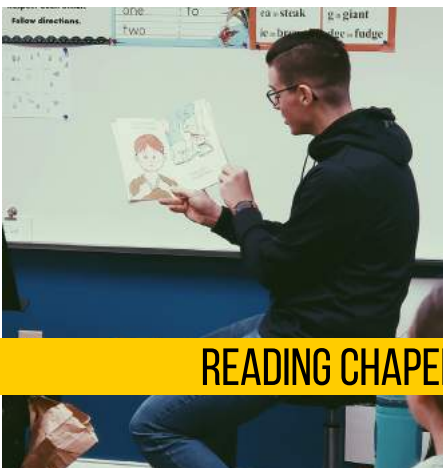
